INQUIRY CONTRACT

HONR 382: Civic Engagement (1-3 credits; may be repeated twice)

This Inquiry encourages students to participate in volunteer experiences outside the major related to their long-term goals. Students will undertake service learning internships that will likely consist of reading and reflection that lead to a research proposal accompanied by related volunteer work. Students will keep detailed journals of their activities and produce a final project.

While the Inquiry will be individually arranged through the Center for Service Learning and Social Entrepreneurship, the Honors Director or Assistant Director will be the instructor of record, responsible for reviewing and grading the project. A completed HONR 382 contract accompanied by an approved authorization form from the Center is required for enrollment in HONR 382. A minimum of 40 hours of volunteer activity is required for each academic credit.
